Seniors should also check with the University/College that you are interested in for more scholarship opportunities offered by that particular institution.

LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Crestview Educational Foundation Scholarship

Must be a Crestview senior with at least a 2.75 GPA, be involved in community service, have leadership capabilities, and plan to attend a 2-4 year accredited school.

Award: \$500 (3)

Academic Boosters of Crestview Scholarship

Must be a Crestview senior who is involved in extra curricular activities, is involved in community service, and is accepted by an accredited school.

NHS Scholarship Program-Students who are seniors in good standing are eligible to be nominated by their chapters to compete in the NHS Scholarship Program. Deadline is January 20, 2012.

Davidson Fellows Scholarship-Must be 18 years old or younger and a U.S. citizen. Deadline is February 1, 2012. Scholarship amount varies.

The Grand Scholarship-Participants are judged based on their initial application, on-site debates, and participation during the week. Multiple students receive scholarships in the first round and the total number of students selected dictates how much each student will receive. Deadline is March 1, 2012. Scholarship amount varies.

Odenza Marketing Scholarship-In order to be eligible, you must be between the ages of 16 and 25 on March 30, 2012. Must submit answers to the essay questions, which can be found on the application page. Deadline is March 30, 2012. Scholarship amount is \$500.

Vancouver Restaurant Scholarship-To be eligible for this scholarship you must be between the ages of 15-21 as of May 30, 2012, be a full time student in 2012 in either High School or College/University, and answer the essay question found on the application page. Deadline is May 30, 2012. Scholarship amount is \$500.

Healthy Lifestyles Scholarship-To be eligible for this scholarship you must be under 25 years of age by May 30, 2012 and be a senior in high school or in your first year of College/University. Deadline is May 30, 2012. Scholarship amount is \$5000.

Big Dig Scholarship-To be eligible for this scholarship you must currently be in grade 12 and entering into your first year of College/University in 2012 and submit an essay that is under 1000 words by June 1, 2012. The amount of the scholarship is \$3000.

Man Mac Automatic Scholarship-This scholarship is available to any student enrolled in high school and is planning on attending College/University. Deadline is June 15, 2012. The amount of the scholarship is \$500.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

DO I HAVE TO FILL OUT A FAFSA FORM?

Yes, if you are seeking any financial assistance from colleges/universities.

When filling out the FAFSA you will need the following:

- Records for income earned in the year prior to when you will start school.
- Register for a pin number. The both of you-parent and student-need to have a pin #. Once you have registered, print a hardcopy of it and keep it in a file for use later.
- For the 2010-2011 school year, you will need 2010 information.

You will need to refer to:

- Your Social Security card and driver's license
- W-2 Forms or other records of income earned
- Your Federal Income Tax return
- Your parent's Federal Income Tax return
- Records of other untaxed income received such as welfare benefits, social security benefits, TANF, veteran's benefits, or military or clergy allowances
- Current bank statements and records of stocks, bonds, and other investments
- Business of farm records if applicable
- Your alien registration card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

If you are applying for a scholarship and financial aid, there is something you need to know:

Many colleges include a scholarship award in the student's financial aid package. The scholarship money does not reduce the amount of money your family is required to pay, in other words, the "Estimated Family Contribution" is not reduced.

For example, if a student's total college expenses for a year are \$12,000 and the student's EFC indicates that the family can afford to pay \$4,000 the student needs \$8,000 in financial aid. If the scholarship award is \$2,000 the student still must pay what the family can afford - \$4,000. The \$8,000 in financial aid (loans) is, instead, reduced by the \$2,000 scholarship to a total of \$6,000.
